Project Title: Vax4Health: A research project to co-design school vaccination services with people with disability (Phase 2)



What is the project about?

Young people with disability get vaccines at school to help them stay healthy. We want to find ways to make getting vaccines at special schools easier – for students and families, as well as schools and nurses. We'll do this through co-design. Co-design is when people work together to make something better.



Who can participate?

We are looking for people aged 18 years and older who want to help make vaccine services better at special schools, including:

- People with intellectual disability and/or autism
- Parents of young people with intellectual disability and/or autism
- •Education staff (teachers, principals, support officers, admin)
- •Health staff (nurses, program coordinators, policymakers)



What will participants do?

Participants will be part of a group made up of 16-20 people with and without disability. We'll work together in 6 face-to-face workshops over 1 year. Each workshop will last 2 hours and involve fun and creative activities to learn from each other and make vaccine services better.
